

Proposed Sydney Rams Constitution changes to the 2025 AGM agenda

- **Remove the need for compulsory membership to TBAL**

Current

Affiliation:

6. Upon agreement of majority of the members at the yearly reformation meeting, the league may apply to be sanctioned by the Tenpin Bowling Australia Limited (TBAL) in accordance with its League Schedule. In this case the league accepts and will abide by the TBAL Rule Book. In any event the league shall be bound by the general playing rules of the sport of tenpin as defined by the TBAL or its American counterpart.

6. Upon agreement of majority of the members at the yearly reformation meeting, the league may apply to be sanctioned by the Tenpin Bowling Australia Limited (TBAL) in accordance with its League Schedule. In this case the league accepts and will abide by the TBAL Rule Book. In any event the league shall be bound by the general playing rules of the sport of tenpin as defined by the TBAL or its American counterpart. Individual membership of TBAL by Sydney Rams members is at their own discretion (is not compulsory) and expense.

- **New year averages recalculated after 21 games (rather than the current 9 games)**

Playing and other regulations

Current

11. Commencement Averages

11.1. A bowler who has

11.1.1. Previously Bowled 21 or More Games in this League – shall have her/his previous seasons finishing average applied in any given new season.

11.1.2. Previously Bowled 21 or More Games but not in this League -Highest current average in any League in which 21 or more games have been played. If no current average, then the highest yearbook average over 21 games.

11.1.3. Previously Bowled, but not 21 Games in one League - Current average in the League in which the most games have been bowled or the highest Yearbook average, whichever is the highest.

11.2. The above averages shall be used for the first nine (9) games of the new season. After nine games have been bowled, the total current seasons pin fall will be divided by nine (9) to determine the new average.

11.3. No Previous Experience:

11.3.1. A Bowler shall bowl three (3) games and have the total pins divided by three (3) to determine the average to be used.

11.4. Premiership points will be allocated to teams from the beginning of the season using the above averages.

11. Commencement Averages

11.1. A bowler who has

11.1.1. Previously Bowled 21 or More Games in this League – shall have her/his previous seasons finishing average applied in any given new season.

11.1.2. Previously Bowled 21 or More Games but not in this League -Highest current average in any League in which 21 or more games have been played. If no current average, then the highest yearbook average over 21 games.

11.1.3. Previously Bowled, but not 21 Games in one League - Current average in the League in which the most games have been bowled or the highest Yearbook average, whichever is the highest.

11.2. The above averages shall be used for the first 21 games of the new season. After nine games have been bowled, the total current seasons pin fall will be divided by 21 to determine the new average.

11.3. No Previous Experience:

11.3.1. A Bowler shall bowl three (3) games and have the total pins divided by three (3) to determine the average to be used.

11.4. Premiership points will be allocated to teams from the beginning of the season using the above averages.
